What to Expect on Your Engagement Photoshoot

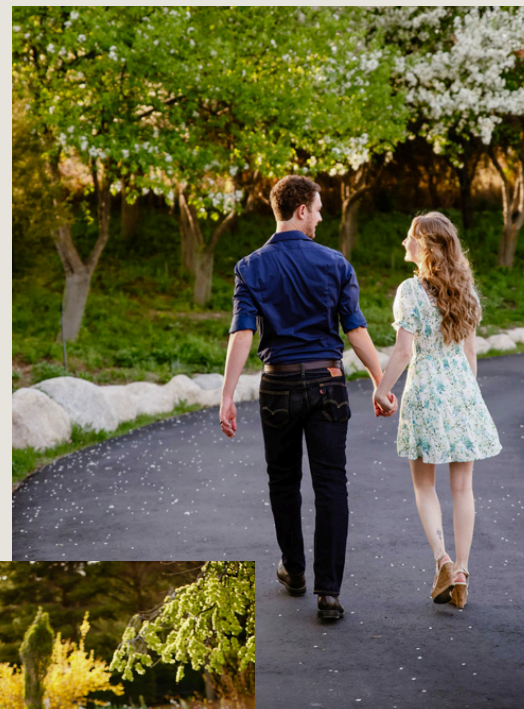


Hello & Welcome
